Corrigan Fundraising Continues to Show Strong Support

Corrigan's War Chest Larger than Previous Dooley Opponents Combined

Brentwood – St. Louis County Executive Candidate Bill Corrigan announced impressive fourth quarter fundraising totals today. The St. Louis native raised \$212,975 in the quarter ending December 31st, with \$503,166.10 Cash on Hand. In just under seven months since launching his campaign Corrigan has raised a total of \$590,035 from 993 donors.

“Republicans, Democrats and Independents continue to join my campaign to clean up county government,” said Corrigan. “I am excited and humbled to have nearly 1,000 individual donors sign on to my campaign during these tough economic times. Their endorsement is yet another sign that the people of St. Louis County demand new leadership and a real vision for our future.”

Corrigan is providing concrete solutions for the problems St. Louis County faces every day. First, he proposed his Code of Ethics for St. Louis County Government in September. A county first, Corrigan’s Code focuses on greater accountability, improving transparency and restoring fairness and honesty in county government. In November, as county tax bills hit residents’ mailboxes, Corrigan proposed a Tax Reform Plan that imposes a moratorium on property tax rate

increases; proposes a cap on increases in property values; calls for an election of a County Assessor; and demands comparable homes sales comparisons that are fair.

“The people of St. Louis County demand more accountability, less politics and more solutions,” said Corrigan. “My campaign is focused on solving the problems that all county residents, from Florissant to South County, face together.”

Corrigan’s fundraising has impressively outpaced previous opponents of controversial County Executive, Charlie Dooley. The previous two candidates to run against Charlie Dooley raised a combined total of \$573,830.47 (Gene McNary raised a total of \$554,441 in 2004 and Joe Passanise raised \$19,389.47 in 2006).

“Already my campaign has raised more campaign cash than Charlie Dooley’s previous two opponents,” said Corrigan. “The people of St. Louis County understand that the time is now to act and the time is now for real leadership and real vision for our county.”

Corrigan’s career includes extensive professional and community leadership experience. He was one of the youngest presidents of the Missouri Bar, he has held numerous leadership roles in his law firm, and he served on the boards of such charitable organizations as the Edgewood Children’s Center, Cardinal Glennon Children’s Hospital and the Make-A-Wish Foundation.
